## 1.) impuls Minute Concerts. Walk through Galleries with Music

## **impuls** minute concerts

impuls recently has offered workshops under the guidance of Dimitrios Polisoidis in Graz and Vienna to more than 45 young musicians living in Austria. During these workshops both works of **New** and **Contemporary music** (by composers like John Cage, Roman Haubenstock-Ramati, György Kurtág, Steve Reich and Salvatore Sciarrino, but also young composers like Pasquale Corrado and Yukiko Watanabe) as well as musical performances and improvisational concepts were introduced, rehearsed and developed further on. Parts of the results will be performed in public at the impuls Minute Concerts on April 28th, 2012, lasting from 10.30 am till 10.00 pm and taking place in different galleries and art institutions in Graz.

At each location the audience can experience short performances of **music** as well as a tour through the exhibition. There will also be enough time to stroll around the city of Graz and meet up with the artists - the musicians as well as fine artists and curators - and exchange with other friends of the arts and fellowmen. The excursion will end at Forum Stadtpark in the evening with several concerts to follow still. Each composition will only be presented once (alltogether more than 30 different works are scheduled throughout the day), the entrance is free.

## 3.) impuls and the Ernst Krenek Commission


